Charles H. Schoen Optimist Memorial Scholarship

For Two-year and Vocational Program Studies

What is the Charles H. Schoen Optimist Memorial Scholarship?

The scholarship is open to students planning to attend a two-year (Associates degree) program or other vocational-technical training.

In addition to the many two-year Associates Degree programs offered by Colleges and Universities, programs such as medical technician, A & P mechanic, and similar vocational studies qualify for the scholarship.

One Scholarship is awarded every year for one year in the amount of \$600.00 per semester or \$1,200.00 per year.

Is it grade dependant?

Applicants need have only a "C" average to win this scholarship. Service to the community and the ability to demonstrate that you have an interest in and an understanding of the field you intend to enter are also important considerations.

Who is eligible?

You need not be a student at Avon High School. Seniors at private schools and home-schooled students are also eligible.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Be a graduation senior.
2. Be a resident of Washington Township, Hendricks County, Indiana.
3. Intend to pursue vocational training.
4. Maintain a C average in High School.
